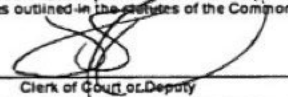
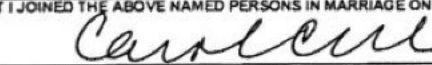


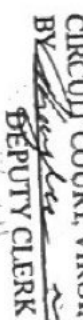

FINAL DECREE – DIVORCE FROM THE BONDS OF MATRIMONY

This action was heard today after having been regularly docketed, matured, and set for hearing.

Pursuant to Rule 1:13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, the Court waives the requirement for counsel or the parties to endorse this Order.

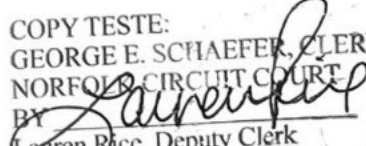
Let the Clerk forward certified copies of this Order to the parties at their last known addresses.
